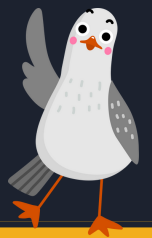

# Code of Conduct

## Safe Space

WCS Den Haag is dedicated to providing a safe space for everyone, no matter their gender, race, nationality, age, ability, sexual orientation, physical appearance, religion or any other personal characteristic.

## Code of conduct

- All attendees and staff are subject to our code of conduct.
- We have a zero tolerance policy on harassment be it racist, sexist, homophobic or transphobic abuse, unwanted sexual attention or sexual assault.
- Drug use or being under the influence of drugs is prohibited at our venues.
- If the code of conduct is breached we reserve the right to remove the participant from current and future events.

## Asking someone to dance

- We encourage anyone to ask anyone to dance. Anyone can respond with 'no, thank you.' An explanation is never required.
- We believe that dance roles are unrelated to gender. Don't assume that someone dances a certain role just based on appearances.
- To have clear communication when asking someone to dance, it's good to state your preferred role or ask. For example: "Hi, would you like to dance the next song? Would you prefer to lead or follow?"



# Code of Conduct

## Floorcraft

While dancing, you invite people into your personal space and enter other people's personal space. While there is always some risk associated with any physical activity, we are committed to preventing injuries before they happen. Unsafe dancing is any movement that puts anyone at an increased risk of physical injury.

- Social dances are not the time or place for aerials.
- Be aware of the space around you and account for this in the moves you do. If you should bump into anyone, check-in with them and offer an apology.

## Be considerate of others

- Good hygiene can make dancing more comfortable for everyone, so bring a change of clothes, deodorant & mints if you need them.
- Our classes and social dances are not the place for unsolicited feedback. This is reserved for teachers or when your partner explicitly asks for it.

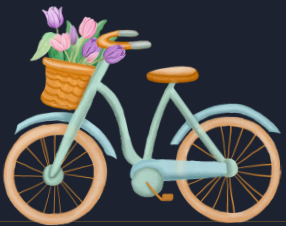

# Getting here



## By car

If you're coming by car, you can use [this map](#) to check for street parking nearby. Green areas are free!



## By train

If you're coming by train, please note that **Den Haag Centraal** station will be closed for train traffic that weekend :(

Fear not, because the station itself will still be open for public transport (bus/tram/metro), and it's one tram stop away from the event, or 10 min walk.

There are two other train stops you can use:

- **Den Haag Laan v NOI** - closest to the event location
- **Den Haag HS**
